

FYRA Rulebook Changes for website Newsflash

*2010 Permits will be a flat fee of \$15.00 per rodeo plus the events entry fees.

*Exhibition prices for 2010 are as follows:

Barrels, Poles, Goat Tying, Calf Roping, Breakaway, Team Roping, Stock Bustin', Wrangler Bulls, and Chute Dogging- \$10.00/rodeo for Members, \$20.00 for Non-Members

JR & SR Bull Riding and Broncs- \$30.00 for Members, \$40.00 for Non-Members

*Number of rodeos for Finals Qualification will be 6 rodeos/event.

*All stock will be drawn for and then chute run. Therefore all contestants in that event must be ready to compete at the beginning of the event!!

*All monies won in any event (including Team Roping) will count towards year end and all around standings.

*Contestant's will run with a closed gate in the barrel racing and pole bending events- No Exceptions!

*Contestant's may enter/compete in both the Calf Roping and Breakaway events.

*In team roping, contestant's may enter once at finals on each end qualified for.

*STOCK BUSTIN'-Due to FYRA not being able to provide a more evenly competitive pen of stock in the stock bustin' event- these will be the new rules for the event. See also your rulebook! This change has become necessary in order for us to still be able to offer the event- and will still allow the kids to prepare for the bull riding events.

Stock Bustin'- event coordinator- Kelly McAlhane

1- 4 seconds makes a qualified ride.

2- No scores given, NO RERIDES! No draw for the stock. Chute Run only! Contestant will be drawn for position in events order.

3- No points accumulated!

4- A child may **not** enter the Wrangler Bull riding and then return to the stock bustin'.

5- The age limit is 6 years old as of Nov. 1st of current rodeo year. See also Rule #5 General Rules.

6- Contestants must use a mouthpiece- and may also use a rope, vest, and helmet.

7- The judge has the option of turning out a contestant who is unwilling to participate. No entry fees will be refunded.

8- Any type of sheep, goats, or unflanked dairy calves may be used. If animal has horns they must be tipped.

9- Entry fees will be \$15.00 per rodeo. \$5.00 stock fee, \$5.00 pay back to each contestant, and \$5.00 towards a year end trophy award for each contestant qualified for the FYRA finals- which is 6 rodeos rode in the event.
